This evolved and meaty pinot has a deep, faintly raisined and earthy bouquet whose scents of plums and redcurrants are backed by dark chocolate, suede leather, cloves and cinnamon. Dark and fiery, its kernelly palate of plums and prunes, currants and dark cherries overlies a fine, supple, bony undercarriage and a hint of molasses. 92 points

Meres needs plenty of air to shake a wet, wool-like shroud off aromas of dark cherries, bracken, savoury oak, North African spice and an earthy edge. The palate has a contained, simple shape, based around ripe mid-palate tannin and a solid finish. Will be interesting to see if this lifts over time. 92 points.
