Another regional take on pinot gris with attitude, the immediate impression here is that there's much more built into this wine than the usual simple apple and pear lines. You can sense the use of oak, grape and yeast solids adding complexity but not overriding the white fruit flavours, then further into the drinking they all show up to provide a fine-textured mouthfeel that's totally delicious.
