The finish is on another path, citrus and acidity tightening and brightening the aftertaste in particular. Despite this change in flavour, the wine has good line and focus. To: 2025.

Very elegant and stylish, this translucently clear, almost brittle chardonnay has a faintly chalky and mineral bouquet of white peach, grapefruit and creamy, buttery vanilla oak backed by a hit of clove. Medium to full-bodied, its long and linear, revealing some lusciousness and fleshiness of fruit before finishing with a crisp acidity, a lemon pith-like texture and a lingering core of flavour.
