Kooyong's Single Vineyard Pinots exhibit darker shades across the variety's multitude of personalities. There is an energy, a weightlessness, together with richness. The fruit ekes its way out of the savoury maze, licked with bramble, beetroot and etched by a whole cluster spike of aniseed and cardamom. The balance of fruit intensity and structural attributes augur well for a very bright future. To: 2030.

Distinctively mineral and textured, this gentle and complete pinot is certain to build more weight and texture with age. Delicate aromas of flowers, small berries and cherries, subtle oak and five spice are underpinned by a pungent minerality that seamlessly supports its smooth and complete palate of pure red berries, cherries and a hint of citrus oil. It reminds me of some of the finer and more perfumed wines from Mount Etna.
