Masters of pinot gris, Kooyong, go hand in hand with Port Phillip Estate, so the expectation is great for gris under this label, or at least high-ish. A reliable offering. Lavished with white pear character and sweet stone fruit character, this is an approachable, frisky white of good gris character. Shows some slipperiness in texture, a touch of floral lift in aroma and mouth perfume, cool, clean finish. It's perhaps a little watery in its flavour profile, but that doesn't detract from actually drinking it, and a touch of chalkiness through the finish works well. As always, smart packaging seals the deal.
