2015 represents a spicy and savour vintage for Massale, defined by pink pepper and dried herbs over a core of strawberry and raspberry fruit, structured with fine tannins.

This seems a slightly different style to previous Massales. Not sure if it's my imagination, or perhaps the new winemaker.

Spicy, sappy and perfumed with cherry and raspberry and gentle oak in support. Medium bodied, firm feeling wine, again very 'mineral' in acidity and also the tannin departments, but the raspberry fruit carries it along very nicely. It's a serious wine at the price, and almost demands your attention. Finish is long, precise and sappy once more. Engaging. Don't come looking for cuddles here, but if you fancy something more intellectual, you'll be well served.
