



## Port Phillip Estate Red Hill Pinot Noir 2016 – Reviews

From five blocks of the estate vineyard, which has over 5ha planted in differing directions on the steep slopes of red basalt soil. Wild-fermented in a combination of large foudre oak vats and tank, 18 days on skins, matured for 11 months in French barriques (20% new). Has the robust style of Port Phillip Estate, with red and dark fruits contesting possession.
