Grown on a tiny patch of vineyard the wine is fermented wild in old oak before being bottled unfined. It slides seductively along the tongue but it's zippy too. It's another excellent release under this label. Pink grapefruit, lemongrass and citrus flavours give it plenty of impact but it's the resounding finish too and the mouthfeel that really elevate it.
