Port Phillip Estate doesn't get it wrong very often. This 2018 release from the Balnarring sub-region of the Mornington Peninsula is another victory for the label. It's tangy and tart with excellent complexity but most of all: drinkability. It slips down easily and well. Sweet beetroot, earth, red cherries and dry, woody spice notes. Plenty going on, long lines of flavour, disciplined tannin and a burst of something extra through the finish.
