Red fruit, a sort of potpourri and bush land perfume, a little spice and almond. Fine-bones, slightly sappy but going into a raspberry cordial sort of flavour, though has a sort of limpid quality and rather appealing fine graphite tannin. There's some rhubarb and earth in the mix too, and the finish is clean, fairly long, and quite spicy. Some more time in the bottle should serve it well.
