



## Port Phillip Estate Red Hill Chardonnay 2018 – Reviews

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### Degustation for Dignity

Since becoming chief winemaker at Port Phillip Estate a few years ago, Glen Hayley has taken the estate's already good wines to new levels of quality and detail. This wine from the very good 2018 vintage, was made predominantly from an east-facing hillside block of vines first planted in the late 1980's and was fermented wild in barrel using ambient yeasts. An excellent expression of modern Australian chardonnay: pure, zesty, with a lovely line of minerality running through it. Unlike some modern Australian chardonnay though it is not lean and mean: there is still plenty of the chardonnay grapes characteristic richness and texture to be found.
