The ironstone pebbles of this site infuse a fine mineral texture that elevates its strawberry and morello cherry fruit and draws out a long finish. It's spicy, characterful and focused with bright acidity and confident, finely structured tannins promising good potential.

The vines on the Ferrous block are now 21 years old. It's a 0.7 hectare block. Firm, sturdy, tangy, quite a bit of oak but the wine more or less carries it. Sour cherries and dried fragrant herbs meet sweet, smoky oak. It's seductive. Balance is pretty close to perfect; another 6-12 months in bottle should have it bang on.
