Strawberry, and strawberry jam, a slightly minty and gum litter perfume, light cedar oak, rosehip tea and spice. It's light, slightly smoky, crisp in acidity, with a feathering of tannin, a bit sappy/twiggy/autumnal to taste, with redcurrant and cranberry on a frisky finish of solid length, a little emery tannin grip as it goes. Quite dry, a nice wine.
