Piloting a new addition of a blend garnering accolades in the Yarra Valley, from a tradition kick started in the Hunter Valley. Equal portions of fruit, destined with some whole bunches into stainless-steel vats for wild fermentation, aged nine months in used French barriques and blended before bottling. This rendition is exactly what the style should be about, which is vibrancy of fruit and freshness. Spiced plums and cherries with lots of savoury inputs some woody spices, herbs and a succulence across the light-to-mid-weighted palate. Textural tannins and juicy acidity to close. Good one Glen.
