The fruit is gently whole-bunch pressed to old French barriques, fermented wild and left on lees for a couple of months, which explains the excellent texture, complexity and even flow of this wine. It's subtle and savoury, with flinty sulphides but includes grapefruit and pith, white stone fruit and rocket. This is a sauvignon I'd gladly drink anytime.
