The Salasso Rosé from leading Mornington Peninsula winery Port Phillip Estate is one of the most consistent and reliable pale, dry pink wines on the market and the latest vintage, the 2022, is no exception: whole bunch-pressed, wild yeast-fermented, aged in old barriques and foudres with extended lees ageing, it's beautifully fragrant, delicate, textural and just delicious. And now it also comes in a can: 250ml of fabulous pink wine in a handy, lightweight, quickly chillable and easily recycled receptacle. What's not to love?
