Some flinty, smoky sulphides get the tastebuds working overtime. Yet plenty of richness and depth here with fleshy stone fruit, lemon and lime and creamy lees. There's a ripeness too with a touch of vanilla-pod sweetness from the oak. Luscious and convincing.

A terrific Chardonnay, and simply stunning value. A gorgeous nose with lovely ripe stone fruits, notably peaches. There are also hazelnuts, white florals and very well integrated oak, a seductively supple texture and impressive length with explosive flavours throughout. It will drink beautifully over the next four to five years – love it.

The Real Review, March 2023 Huon Hooke

Light to mid yellow colour and a smoky, toasted cashew nut aroma, the palate is rich and full and rounded, with ample stone-fruit, toast and roasted almond flavours. A hint of apricot nectar, and a twist of bitterness from retained phenolics adding a pleasant cleansing note to the aftertaste. Quite powerful, full-throttle chardonnay.
