Cherry, strawberry, and sage, with discreet spice and cedar oak. It's fresh, all cherry pip, and strawberry, light tannin, bright acidity. It's on the money and very good to drink. Frisky red fruits and spice is the import, with plenty of Mornington goodness rolled in. I really like it.

A terrific Massale this vintage with lots of spiced cherries, blood orange and strawberries with more complex notes of fragrant forest floor and a pinch of cedary oak. Lighter framed but not wimpy, as it fleshes out with supple tannins and refreshing acidity. Lunch wine sorted.

Wine Pilot, April 2023

Another very fine Pinot from Kooyong, sourced from their Balnarring and Tuerong vineyards. Fermentation in open vats with wild yeasts for 15 to 18 days. Nine months maturation in a mix of different French oak formats – barriques, puncheons and large format foudre – of which 10% were new. A vibrant garnet hue. Spices, some earthy notes intertwined with florals and dried herbs. A hint of animal skins. An appealing and alluring Pinot Noir nose. The palate is seamless, a soft texture with cushiony tannins. There is also fresh acidity and good length with lovely raspberry notes emerging across the palate. Lots to like here.
