Not the first variety one thinks of from Mornington Peninsula, but there are some fine examples and few better than this one. Deep maroon in colour, the nose has appealing notes of dry herbs, cloves, leather, a smoky touch, cherries and black fruits. Supple on the palate, with very fine tannins and serious length. Youthful, but drinking well, and sure to keep doing so for the next seven to eight years. This is a very fine cool climate Shiraz. Like it a lot.

Wheaty, spicy, bacon bones and blackberry. It's a wine with some zip and spice, distinctly meaty and savoury, some tomato paste here, but also hazelnut and liquorice. The tannin is ripe and gently grainy, and there's a twist of bitter chocolate and pomegranate in the mix too. It's a wine of distinct personality with a cool climate twist.
