## Wine Pilot, February 2023 Ken Gargett

A concentrated and powerful style of Chardonnay, the nose has hints of peaches, cashews and lemon rind. There is coiled power here and a slightly firm texture. Good intensity right through. Enjoyable now, but it will be even better in two years and will then drink impressively for another four to six.

## The Real Review, February 2023 Huon Hooke

Creamy cashew-nutty aromas, light yellow colour, a restrained and yet open and immediately appealing wine. Fruit drives it. There is a touch of fruit sweetness in the mid-palate and the wine is fruity and charming as well as reserved and discreet, with a certain tannin firmness which fits neatly into the wine as a whole. 91 points

## Vinous, May 2023 <u>Angus Hughson</u>

The single vineyard 2021 Balnarring Chardonnay boasts attractive purity and precision with layers of grapefruit, nectarine and a strong backing of French oak. There is beautiful volume and texture punctuated by fresh acid bite, drawing out a surprisingly long finish. It's drinking well but with time on its hand.
