A concentrated and powerful style of Chardonnay, the nose has hints of peaches, cashews and lemon rind. There is coiled power here and a slightly firm texture. Good intensity right through. Enjoyable now, but it will be even better in two years and will then drink impressively for another four to six.

There is a touch of fruit sweetness in the mid-palate and the wine is fruity and charming as well as reserved and discreet, with a certain tannin firmness which fits neatly into the wine as a whole.
