Vines planted in 1996 on a 40-ha vineyard in Tuerong. Northfacing, 100–120 m, clay soils. Sustainable viticulture. 15% whole bunch, 15% new oak. Sweet strawberry nose. Lovely herbal lift and mesh. Tannins are laminar over river-pebble minerality giving the wine mouth-watering determination. Blood orange and thirst-quenching.

Fruit off the four single blocks, each of which make up their own wine. Here it's a super fragrant, juicy combo of red and black cherries, fresh herbs, loads of Middle Eastern spices, sumac, clove and Chinese five-spice; a baker's delight really. The palate is on the lighter side of mid-weighted, with lots of fresh acidity keeping this buoyant, tannins light and fine. Smart outcome given a difficult vintage.
