Citrus blossom, lemon, grapefruit, citrus peel and spice aromas. Energy to burn and grip on the palate tied to brisk acidity. Citrus flavours to the fore area delight. Combines texture and mealy, nutty warmth with a background oak spiciness – top, all-round chardonnay drinking and, if you wish, cellaring.

Crystalline bright lemon hue. White peach, bacon fat and nougat aromatics. Palate has density and power but sits fresh, lively and lifted. Fruit has white peach purity, smoky bacon and nuts bring savoury contrast and saline minerality offers tension and accentuates the vigour and drive of the acidity. An outstanding chardonnay that offers power and freshness, with a prodigious length and a twisting tension that carries from entry to end.
