Comes from 17 year old vines, and gets no new oak, though 33% second fill puncheons were employed. Hand-picked, 10% whole bunch. It's spicy, a little sappy, raspberry and redcurrant, with a light meaty and red capsicum whole bunch character. Medium-bodied, offers excellent cranberry crunch and freshness, emery board tannin, just a little bit nutty too, with a bright red fruited finish of excellent length, laced with some blood orange. It's light, finely wrought, and so compelling. So stylish. So good.
