I sat with this for a while, or for longer than I needed to, because I was enjoying it so much. A pinot gris, no less, even though I'm surrounded by chardonnay. It has body but it also feels zippy. It tastes of pears and apples but there are other more exotic fruit influences here, along with herbal inflections, and excellent texture too; not too much of the latter, just enough to make it feel polished. There's a floral, almost soapy, aspect to the aromatics, which would normally be a negative but it works here and is entirely a positive. This wine is money well spent.
