Medium to full ruby red, bright in the glass. Red cherry, river stone, and charcuterie aromatics. The fruit is more centred, more black cherry, and develops on the palate with a silkiness that is instantly appealing. It's slippery and flowing, but with enough acidity and tannin to keep focus and drive as it glides incredibly long. With time, more details emerge: cured meat, hints of fresh rosemary, and a truffle undergrowth detail that suggests a similar food match will really see it sing.
